Do we Really believe in the power of prayer?

Instinctively every Christian will reply with a resounding yes! Yet we still find that prayer meetings are the least attended meetings in almost every church. Why is this? We claim to believe that prayer is not only effective but very powerful and in fact most Christians...will seek out a person they perceive to be a Godly representative to pray for their needs...even though we have the same authority to enter his presence [Heb 4:16]. So why is prayer such a stumbling block in the Christians daily walk?

The main problem is that the only part of our being that was born again is our spirit. Our flesh and our soul cannot pray as it is carnal and rooted in the things of this world; which Paul said in Romans is at enmity with God [Rom 8:7]. Unless we break through this barrier of the flesh and soul realm and enter the spirit realm [John 4:24] then prayer feels more like a heavy burden than a privilege. Therefore, the enemy seeks to keep us in this unproductive carnal realm, and if he is successful then he keeps us from our victories and we permit the circumstances of this world to take precedence over the Truth of God's Word. What is it that the enemy fears about prayer?

Prayer is a legal petition to **invoke the will of God** here on earth. Moreover God has covenanted to grant us our petitions!

1 John 5: 14 and this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask anything **according to his will**, he hears us: and if we know that he hears us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

As with everything we ought to take our lead from the Word of God with Jesus Christ setting the example. If we consider his Prayer is a legal petition to invoke the will of God here on earth!




Our flesh cannot pray!

For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot.


prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane then we see that Jesus also had to relinquish His will to the will of Father. In anguish of the circumstances of the day and the fate that lay before him he cried out for another way, and then in obedience he relinquished his will to the will of the father... nevertheless not my will but Thine be done! [Luke 22:42]. If we are honest then we will admit that often our will does not line up with the will of the father. We enter into prayer with our own preconceived ideas on what we deemed to be an acceptable outcome. Therefore we are reluctant to relinquish our will in fear that God will choose to answer contrary to <u>our</u> will, because usually God 's will does not lineup with anything we like to do! Just like spoilt children our petitions are not really requests for what is good for us but instead are a list of demands to fulfil our selfish desires!



Prayer is not coercing God to line up with our thinking but is an invitation from God for us to lineup with *His* thinking so we can invoke *His* will. If we consider the protocol of the Old Testament priests to enter into the holy of holies; it was a process of self cleansing that involved sacrificing self will and shedding all that is carnal to find out what God wanted to say to them. How often do we [who know nothing] spend all of our prayer time talking without waiting to hear from God's [who knows all things], and then we wonder why we have missed it!

Some years back J Barner printed statistics from a survey on the length of time the average Christian prays in a day. The results were startling! According to that particular survey the average Christian spends just one minute per day in prayer, and even more startling Pastors were averaging only five minutes per day! Surely we cannot think that we can enter into the presence of

Heb 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.





Making the Word of God our Native Language!

Without detracting from the irrefutable truth of God Grace and finished work of the cross, we

have a responsibility to line up our life by identifying with the Word [Rom 12:2]. Our lifestyle is important! We are admonished to abide in Him [John 15:4-8] and walk in love [Eph 5:1-2] that we might [as ambassadors of the kingdom of heaven] represent Him appropriately. Besides do you really want to carry the baggage from your past into your future? We were initially born again when we identified Christ as our Saviour. However, accepting Christ as our Saviour could be actioned with a minimal amount of knowledge!



At this point we were delivered from darkness and translated into a new kingdom, the Kingdom of Light [Col 1:12-13] and awarded a new citizenship card...our passport was stamped! [Phil 3:20]

Consider how debilitating it would be to live in a foreign country without ever learning the language? Simple tasks like ordering a meal in a restaurant, asking for directions, getting a bus, shopping in the local supermarket would be difficult and restrictive. However, if you have developed some basic language skills then you are sufficiently equipped generally to ask directions, use public transport and basically get through a routine day. **However, your limitations are immediately apparent to the natives!**

Since our 'native language' was that of the devils, and our 'native country' was the kingdom of



darkness, then we need to familiarise ourselves with the language native to the country we now hold our current citizenship with – The Kingdom of Light! We have been rescued from the hands of the tyrant the bible calls the god or the prince of this world [John 14:30; John 16:11]. We do not need to familiarise ourselves 'enough to get by'—we need to turn it into our FIRST language— This is our new home; this is where we live, not the place we come to visit on holiday!

How? God said... renew your mind daily...[Rom 12:2]. We learn our new language from the Word of God!

If we only familiarise ourselves 'enough to get by' then we will always feel like a foreigner, and will risk returning to our old ways and our old lifestyles, because our foundations are weak [Psalm 11: 3; Luke 6:48-49].

Consider; we are now sojourners on earth [1 Peter 2:11; 1 Chron 29:15] and we have an enemy who intends us harm pursuing after us [1 Peter 5:8]; should we not use wisdom and discernment?  - o The 'driving force' behind chasing ungodly values is Satan (seeking unproductive activities that never satisfy)...and the driving force behind ungodly actions/responses in our lives is Pride (stubbornness ...always having to be right, having last word, self seeking behaviours!) The Mind is our Personal Government; making decisions, choices ...it SETS THE STANDARD in our life!
 - o NO WORD OR ACTION IS A RANDOM EVENT! We think it then we deliberate to do it!

The mind has often been compared to a computer system and in fact is the most advanced and sophisticated system known to man ...yet unfortunately is often under control of a technical incompetent!

Our DNA is the **unique world changing <u>DESTINY CODE</u>** God programmed each of us with! It required a programmer and operates according to specific rules!

Our mind is programmed to receive and process information in a very specific way; today we have more technological information available to us than any other era.

Knowledge is increasing and education advancing ...so what is our problem?

What is Stress?

Stress is our <u>UNMANAGED REACTION</u> to disappointments, or our response to any pressure that disrupts the normal balance.
